Congratulations to parishioner Cris Smith, who was awarded the prestigious King Charles III Coronation Medal, on March 13th at an investiture ceremony in Woodbridge.

Recipients of the award were chosen based on the criteria "Have made a significant contribution to Canada or to a particular province, territory, region or community of Canada" This distinguished honor underscores Cris' unwavering dedication, hard work, and profound impact on our community and nation. Her nomination by peers and community members reflects the deep respect and appreciation for her valuable contributions. She joins 30,000 deserving Canadians nationwide who will receive this award in 2025.

"Cris Smith is an entrepreneur, community leader, and advocate for youth with special needs. For 40 years, she has turned personal challenges into impactful initiatives, notably through the Sara Elizabeth Centre (SEC), founded in 2006 in memory of her daughter. SEC offers arts based programs promoting inclusion for youth with disabilities. She also founded the Blue Veil Charity in 2006, supporting school safety, anti-bullying, and character building initiatives. Her work has earned recognition, including the Canada 150 Community Leader Award and the International Women's Day Appreciation Certificate. Cris' dedication to faith, family and service continues to inspire her community."


