

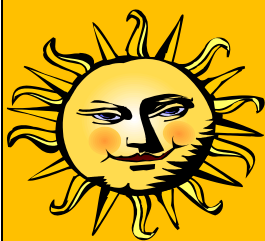

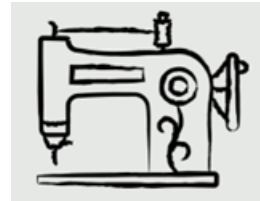

Pope Leo's First Encyclical:

Magnifica Humanitas

On Safeguarding the Human Person in the time of Artificial Intelligence

In his first encyclical, Magnifica Humanitas, Pope Leo XIV appeals for artificial intelligence to be placed firmly at the service of humanity, warning against technologies that foster domination, exclusion and war. The Holy Father insists that no one must be excluded from digital transformation and that human beings can never be reduced to "productivity," "cognitive performance," or "mere data." He affirms that "The person bears within him - or herself - a freedom, an interiority and a vocation to love and worship that no machine can replace or block"
