

**Excerpt from Cardinal Leo's Letter to the Faithful** on the Solemnity of St. Michael the Archangel & Invitation to Pray Novena to St. Michael, September 20-28



As many know, St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica, anchored in the heart of the city, is named after St. Michael the Archangel. Our feast recalls that the archdiocese's very identity is stamped by the ministry of St. Michael: to worship God, resist evil, protect the vulnerable, and serve the common good. When faced with a worldview that is myopically focused on the passing things of this world, a lost sense of sin. and promotion of harmful individualism, St. Michael's patronage encourages us to be discerning, forward looking, and all-encompassing by recalling the primacy of God and placing our trust in God alone.
